ACADEMIC SUCESS

Math Corps Update: We are excited to share that our Math interventionist teachers, helped our K-3 students show growth, with an average increase of 60%. As a result, 17 students were able to exit the program in the first half of the year.

Reading Corps Overview: Our Reading interventionists have also made significant impacts. On average, each student attended 29 sessions, spending 60 minutes per week in tutoring. Impressively, 84.2% of students exceeded their growth targets.
