K-12 Computer Science Grant Awarded to Bultum Academy!

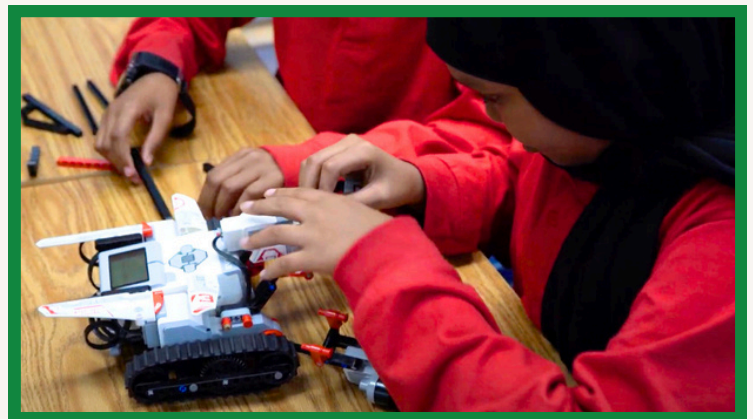
