STEM PLAY DAY

The STEM Play Day, organized by FOSRSE (Friends of Science, Research, and STEM Education), provided an engaging opportunity for Pre-K students to delve into the world of science, technology, engineering, and math through hands-on activities. Children participated in interactive stations that introduced them to basic STEM concepts, such as building structures with blocks, learning about balance, and experimenting with simple machines like pulleys and ramps.

In addition to engineering activities, students engaged in interactive coding exercises that fostered early problem-solving skills, as well as nature exploration that taught them about ecosystems using natural materials. The day was filled with fun and learning, allowing students to develop critical thinking skills and a passion for STEM in a playful environment.





BOOK TALK WITH ZINET KEMAL

Student Council Club

Coordinated by Ms. Aisha and Ms. Zahra, the Student Council is a leadership program for students in grades 5-7.

Meetings occur on Thursdays from 4:15–5:15 PM, focusing on event planning, school improvement projects, and representing student voices. Leadership positions, such as President, are available for grades 6 and 7, providing valuable opportunities for peer leadership.

Media Club

The Media Club offers students in grades 3-7 an outlet for creativity and self-expression. Guided by Ms. Asmaa and Ms. Lokho, students will learn photography, videography, and digital storytelling skills. This program runs on Mondays from 4:15–5:15 PM and will begin as soon as enrollment is finalized, with space limited to approximately 15 participants for personalized guidance.
